

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LUMBERPORT, HARRISON COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Chapter 17C of the West Virginia Code, as amended, together with all of the laws of the State and all rules, regulations and orders made by the Public Service Commission of the State and the State Department of Highways, in effect on the effective date of this section, insofar as such laws, rules, regulations and orders relate or apply to motor vehicles or traffic upon the streets, highways and public ways of incorporated villages, towns and cities, shall be deemed to be and are hereby adopted and made a part of this ordinance as though copied herein fully.

Section 2. Compliance with state traffic laws, rules, regulations and orders made part of this ordinance is mandatory and any violation of such laws, rules, regulations and orders shall be a violation of this ordinance. Provided, that nothing in this ordinance shall be construed as adopting or incorporating herein any law, rule, regulation or order, the violation of which constitutes a felony.

Section 3. That any matters in said Chapter 17C and state traffic laws, rules, regulations and orders made part of this ordinance, which are contrary to existing ordinances of the Town of Lumberport, Harrison County, West Virginia, shall prevail and, to that extent any existing Ordinances to the contrary are hereby repealed in that respect only.

Section 4. That within said Chapter 17C and state traffic laws, rules, regulations and orders made part of this ordinance, when reference is made to the duties of certain officials named therein, that the designated official in the Town of Lumberport, Harrison County, West Virginia, who has duties corresponding to those of the officials so named, shall be deemed to be the responsible official insofar as enforcing the provisions of this ordinance are concerned.

Section 5. Whoever violates any provision of this ordinance or any rule or regulation

lawfully make pursuant t hereto, for which no penalty is otherwise provided, shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) .

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 90 days after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
