

CHAPTER 38

Article I, Section I

The Council of the Town of Lumberport voted to accept the water rate increase on the second reading at the August 3, 1981 meeting. The schedule of increase is as follows:

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full within fifteen(15) days of date of bill, ten percent(10) will be added to the amount of the bill.

A new minimum rate to be \$6.50 for the first two thousand gallon inside. Outside minimum to \$7.30 for the first two thousand gallons.

Tapping Fee to raise from \$75.00 to \$200.00 inside, and from \$85.00 to \$225.00 outside.

CHAPTER 39

SECTIONS I: DEFINITIONS

The following definitions shall be used to interpret this ordinance:

PERSON: Shall mean an individual, corporation, partnership, association or any undefined owner or occupant within the Town of Lumberport, which at any time may require the use of the fire department.

RESIDENCE: Shall mean any dwelling, rooms, apartment or any other structure which is capable of being used as a dwelling unit, owned or occupied by any person within the Town of Lumberport, which may require the use of the fire department.

BUSINESS: Shall mean any service station, store, garage, school, rest home, beauty shop, pool room, restaurant or any other undefined structure in which a business is carried on, which may require the use of the fire department.

SECTION II: FEEES

A mandatory fire tax of \$2.00 per month for residence and \$4.00 per month for businesses shall be charged each residence or business, as defined in Section I, within the said Town of Lumberport, for the maintenance of said fire department.

SECTION III: MODE OF COLLECTION

The monthly charge shall be posted upon each garbage card sent to customers within the said Town and shall be paid at the same time as the garbage bill.

SECTION IV: PENALTIES

Anyone refusing to pay said fee, or for violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction be fined not less than \$1.00 or more than \$5.00, and for a second or subsequent offense shall be fined not less than \$5.00 or more than \$10.00.

SECTION V: SEPARABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clauses, phrases or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as separate and independent provision and such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.

SECTION VI: ORDINANCES REPEALED

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect on the 2nd day of November 198I.
