



AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LUMBERPORT,
TO STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, REPEALING SECTION 7 OF CHAPTER XXIV
BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION TO SAID CHAPTER TO BE
DESIGNATED AS SECTION 7A.

CURBING AND PAVING SIDEWALKS:

- a. Upon due Notice in writing or by publishing such notice in a regularly circulated newspaper once each week for a period of two weeks, the owners of any lot abutting upon any sidewalk or footway within the Town of Lumberport shall fail or refuse to curb, re-curb, pave or re-pave the same as required by said Notice, the Town of Lumberport may cause the same to be done at the cost of the Town of Lumberport and the expense thereof shall be assessed against such abutting property owner and collected in the manner provided by law.
- b. It shall be unlawful for any person to take up or remove any curb, paving, concrete, or any other covering of any sidewalk or footway within the Town of Lumberport, without having first obtained an approved permit for the removal of the same.
- c. It shall be unlawful for any person to curb, re-curb, pave or re-pave any sidewalk or footway within the Town of Lumberport, without having first obtained an approved permit for the same.
- d. The construction of any sidewalk, street, footway, driveway approach, retaining wall or walls and/or any other construction to or of the streets, alleys, walkways, of the Town of Lumberport, by an approved permit, when done by any other than the Town of Lumberport, must be constructed to specifications set forth by the Town of Lumberport Engineer or Engineers.

This Ordinance was adopted the 7 day of August 19 72.
