

AMENDMENT

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 24 OF THE TOWN OF LUMBERPORT ORDINANCES BY REPEALING SECTION 2 OF THE SAID ORDINANCE, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION OF SAID CHAPTER TO BE DESIGNATED AS SECTION 2A.

"Parking on the above designated streets and parts of streets shall be limited as follows":

(a) Parking for a period on one (1) hour shall be allowed for the payment of .05 cents.

(b) Parking for a period of two (2) hours shall be allowed for the payment of .10 cents.

and adding thereto a new Article to be designated as Article 2 providing for the regulation of parking and the penalties for the violations of parking rules and regulations.

Section 1. The Town of Lumberport, by the Mayor, shall have authority to establish all non-parking areas, loading zones, eliminate parking on any street, and to regulate by rules all parking within the Town limits.


Section 2. The following are the minimum and maximum fines for rules and regulations now established:


1. Overtime parking at a Meter	\$ 1.00
Failure to report with said ticket within 24 hours shall be	\$ 2.00 to \$10.00
2. Overtime parking in a limited time zone	\$ 2.00 to \$25.00
3. Double Parking	\$ 2.00 to \$25.00
4. Parking in prohibited zone	\$ 5.00 to \$25.00
5. Parking in a bus stop	\$ 5.00 to \$25.00
6. Parking in a loading zone	\$ 5.00 to \$25.00
7. Stopping on wrong side of street	\$ 2.00 to \$25.00
8. Parking at Fire Hydrant	\$ 5.00 to \$25.00
9. Parking on sidewalk	\$ 5.00 to \$25.00
10. Parking too far from curb (12 inches)	\$ 2.00 to \$25.00
11. Running stop sign	\$ 5.00 to \$25.00
12. Night storage on streets	\$ 5.00 to \$25.00

13. Blocking driveway \$ 5.00 to \$ 25.00
14. U-Turn at restricted intersections \$ 5.00 to \$ 25.00

Ordinances and sections thereof that citations are issued for that are not presented to the Mayor or the Police Judge at the Town of Lumberport office within a 24 hour period from the date the citation was issued, will subject the violator to additional charges above the minimum fines.

This Ordinance was adopted the 1st day of November, 1971.
