

## Amendment

An Ordinance to amend Chapter 16 of the Ordinances of the Town of Lumberport, by adding thereto a new Article to be designated as Article 6 relating to Traffic Laws.

Section 1. Effective May 25th., 1971 it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or occupy any motorcycle on any public street, alley or other public place in the Town of Lumberport, West Virginia, unless such person is equipped with a helmet and other safety equipment as provided by the laws of the State of West Virginia, which become effective of this date.

Section 2. Each owner or operator of a motorcycle which is driven upon any of the streets, alleys or other public places in the Town shall secure a valid drivers license therefore before driving or attempting to operate such vehicles upon any of the public streets, alleys, or other public places.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful to operate any motorcycle within said Town limits unless such motorcycle is equipped with a properly attached muffler which reduces the noise of operating of the vehicle to the minimum noise necessary for operating the vehicle, and no person shall use a cut-out, by-pass, unbaffled muffler, or similar device on said vehicle.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motorcycle within the Town limits upon privately owned land of others without the written permission of the said landowner.

Section 5. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motorcycle upon any unopened street or alley within the Town limits which is not currently being used by the general public for motor vehicle traffic.

Section 6. It shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle to enter upon any unopened street or alley within the town limits which is not currently being used by the general public for motor vehicle traffic without permission from the Mayor of the Town of Lumberport.

Section 7. All motorcycles when operated on the streets of the Town of Lumberport shall proceed in a single file and in the center of the driving lane in which they are driving, and shall obey all Town and State traffic laws.

For the purpose of this Ordinance, the term motorcycle shall include any licensed or unlicensed two or three wheeled vehicle which is powered by internal combustion engine or electric motor, and is designed to be ridden by one or more persons.

Any persons violating the provisions of any of the preceding sections of Article 6, shall upon conviction be fined not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00.
