

An ordinance amending and re-enacting Chapter XII - Section 13 of the Code of the Town of Lumberport, providing for certain Minor persons.

Be it ordained by the Town of Lumberport Council, that Chapter XII - Section 13 of the Code of the Town of Lumberport, as amended, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 13:

It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of eighteen years to loiter, idle, wander or play in or upon the streets, highways, alleys, parks, playgrounds, public grounds, public places, public buildings, places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots, the premises of people upon which the minor does not have the permission to trespass, or unsupervised places between the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM of the following day, provided, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to a minor accompanied by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and legal custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and legal custody of the minor, or while the minor is legally employed and is going to or from the place of employment or is engaged in the duties thereof.

Any minor violating the provisions of the preceding paragraph shall be deemed a delinquent child under the provisions of the State Law and shall be dealt with as such under the provisions of such.

It shall be unlawful for the parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and legal custody of a minor under the age of eighteen years, to knowingly permit such a minor to violate paragraph one of the preceding paragraphs.

Any parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and legal custody of a minor under the age of eighteen, may be fined from \$5.00 to \$500.00 for the violation of the preceding paragraph.

Passed by the Council of the Town of Lumberport, on the first reading, this 6th day of October, 1975.

Passed, and to become effective, by the Council of the Town of Lumberport, on the second reading, this 17th day of October, 1975.
